PROGRAM COMPONENTS

MUSIC TRAINING FOR LIFE

Musical initiation process: auditory development, musical appreciation, reading and writing, harmonies, music creation, and choral practice.

Orchestral training process: approach and technical development of the instruments.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

Classes and practices focused on personal and social development: self-esteem, personal value, teamwork, citizenship, among others.

A School for Families: periodic meetings and workshops with parents and caregivers.
